DAY 1 Sunday, June 1: Depart for Italy

Depart from Cincinnati or New York for our pilgrimage to Italy. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served on board.

DAY 2 Monday, June 2: Desanzano

Upon arrival at Milan's Malpensa Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way Tour Manager upon our exit from Customs. Board our private touring bus and continue to Desenzano (1.5-hour drive)

Upon arrival, we will have some free time for an independent lunch. Then, visit the childhood home of St. Angela Merici, "Le Grezze," a historical reference point and sacred place in the memory of the Foundress of the Ursuline Order. See the fields (Brudazzo) where Angela had a mystical vision and was told she would gather a group of women who would become companions to one another, forming a company to do special work for the church. Continue to Piazza del Duomo to visit the baroque cathedral of Desenzano, dedicated to St. Mary Magdalene. Six paintings of Pietro Calcinardi can be found in the nineteenthcentury chapel devoted to St. Angela Merici. We will see the statue of St. Angela Merici, patron Saint of Desenzano, in the main square. Check-in at our hotel. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Desenzano. (D)

DAY 3 <u>Tuesday, June 3: Salò</u>

Breakfast at our hotel. Today we'll visit Salò, a coastal town on Lake Garda's western shore, where the young St. Angela Merici went to live with her uncle after her parents passed away. Our first stop in Salò will be the Church of San Bernadino, a place of historical importance in Angela's life. It was here in Salò, after the death of her sister, that Angela decided to become a Franciscan tertiary. After two years, when her uncle passed away as well, Angela returned to her parents' home in Desenzano, where she started a small school teaching catechism to girls. Enjoy a boat ride on Lake Garda. Independent lunch in Salŏ with time to explore on your own. A visit to the duomo would allow you to see and pray before the crucifix in the sanctuary that was here when Angela lived in Salò. Decorating the duomo are paintings that tell the story of St. Angela's life.

This afternoon, we'll return to Desenzano to visit the castle overlooking the town with spectacular views of Lake Garda. The remainder of the afternoon is free to enjoy Desenzano on your own. (B)

Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Desenzano.

DAY 4 Wednesday, June 4: Brescia

After breakfast, we will visit Brescia, where in 1516 St. Angela's Franciscan superiors asked her to go to help Caterina Patengola, who had lost her husband and sons. While at her house she met Antonio Romano, in whose family household she would live for 14 years. All the time that she lived in Brescia, she welcomed all who came to her for help. She became aware of the young women who were looking for a life of consecration without entering a monastery and felt called by God to create something new in the church. While in Brescia, we will pause to contemplate the life and legacy of St. Angela Merici, and the founding of the company of St. Ursula during her life in this city. We'll begin our tour at the castle, overlooking the city of Brescia in every direction. Continue to the piazza, with its wide-open space welcoming everyone who walks by. It has been said that being like a piazza is central to Angela's spirituality. See the home of Agostino Gallo, where Angela lived for many years. Across the courtyard from the home is the church of St. Clemente (visit is subject to confirmation). At a side altar in the Church of St. Clemente hangs a well-known image of St. Ursula and her companions. St. Angela and her companions would have prayed at this church and seen this image often. Directly to the right we will see a portrait of St. Angela. Continue to the Duomo Vecchio (ancient cathedral in the round) and the modern Church of St. Angela. Our morning will conclude with a visit to the Church of St. Angela, formerly the Church of St. Afra until it was nearly destroyed at the end of WWII. It was here, in a room by the Church of St Afra, that St. Angela lived the last years of her life. We will venerate the relics of St. Angela in Brescia. Attend a scheduled parish Mass in Brescia (to be confirmed).

Independent lunch and afternoon in Brescia; then return to Desenzano.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Desenzano.

DAY 5 Thursday, June 5: Desenzano | Florence

After breakfast, we will leave Desenzano for Florence (3-hour drive). Upon arrival in Florence, we will have time for an independent lunch. After lunch, meet our local guide who will take us to the Accademia Gallery, most famous for its sculptures by the great Renaissance artist, Michelangelo. After our guided visit, continue to the beautiful Piazza del Duomo to see the Cathedral of Santa Maria Del Fiore, crowned with Brunelleschi's magnificent dome; Giotto's Bell Tower; and the Romanesque Baptistry of St. John with Ghiberti's exquisite bronze doors. Our tour concludes at the 13th-century Franciscan Church of the Holy Cross, which holds the tombs of the greatest of Florentine citizens. The remainder of the afternoon is free. Perhaps you'll want to stroll the famous shop-lined bridge Ponte Vecchio and explore the adjacent "Straw Market," or shop for leather, gold, and other Florentine souvenirs.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Florence. (B,D)

DAY 6 Friday, June 6: Florence | Assisi

After breakfast, we will leave Florence for Assisi (2-hour drive), the town of St.

Francis whose life of profound simplicity and detachment St. Angela came to emulate. As we approach Assisi, we will stop to visit the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli, a great basilica built in 1569 and crowned by Alessi's magnificent dome. It encloses the shrine of the "Porziuncula," or the Little Portion Chapel, around which the first Franciscan community was centered, and the place where Clare received the habit from Francis. See the Capella Del Transito, which marks the spot where St. Francis died, and the statue of St. Francis in the courtyard where thornless roses bloom. Independent lunch in Assisi. Then, we will visit the Basilica of St. Clare, the first and most important heroine of the Franciscan movement. View her remains and see the miraculous Crucifix. Check-in at our hotel in Assisi. Free afternoon to explore Assisi on your own. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Assisi. (B,D)

DAY / Saturday, June 7: Assisi | Rome

After breakfast, our local guide will take us to explore the Basilica of St. Francis, a complex composed of two churches built one atop the other. Beneath both churches is the crypt that houses the tomb of St. Francis. The lower basilica dates from 1228 to 1230 and is richly decorated with beautiful stained-glass windows and paintings by some of the most important artists of the 13th and 14th centuries. In the upper basilica, built from 1230 to 1253, we will marvel at the monumental frescoes painted by Giotto, which depict scenes from the life of St. Francis. We'll also visit the Basilica of Santa Maria Maggiore, housing the Tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis. Late morning, leave Assisi for Rome (2.5-hour drive).

In 1525 St. Angela Merici went to Rome for the Holy Year and had an audience with Pope Clement VII. Pope Clement VII had learned of the holiness of Angela and the service that she and her sisters provided to young women in several towns in northern Italy. The Holy Father invited Angela to meet with him. When Angela met with the pope, he heard in more detail about what she had organized. Very impressed, the pope asked her to remain in Rome and to organize a group of women to provide services to the ill. Remembering her vision and the many hours in prayer in which she had sought to do God's will, Angela had to politely, but firmly, tell the Holy Father, "no" as she did not believe it was God's will.

Our journey continues to Rome in this Jubilee Year 2025. On our way to Rome we will stop at Cantine Santa Benedetta, the oldest winery of the Castelli Romani. Here, in this land, wine has been produced for 3,000 years. Enjoy a cooking demonstration of traditional dishes. Enjoy an atmosphere of ancient recipes with ancient secrets and elegant contemporary taste. Check-in at our hotel in Rome. Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

DAY 8 Pentecost Sunday, June 8: Papal Mass | Historic Rome

After an early breakfast, we will go to St. Peter's Basilica. Enter through the Holy Door to receive a plenary indulgence. Attend the 10:00 a.m. Holy Mass on the Solemnity of Pentecost, celebrated by His Holiness Pope Francis. Holy Spirit, help us to see what God is calling us to, as daughters of Angela, in our world today. Independent lunch.

After lunch, we'll go on a walking tour and experience the best of ancient Rome. Begin at the Pantheon. Built more than 1,800 years ago, the magnificent Pantheon still stands as a reminder of the great Roman Empire. The name Pantheon refers to the building's original function as a temple for the gods. When approaching the front of the Pantheon we can still see the original Latin dedication by Marcus Agrippa. Continue to the Church of San Luigi dei Francesi to see the stunning interior, which is home to a trio of Caravaggio masterpieces. Then we'll walk to the Trevi fountain and Piazza di Spagna, one of the most famous squares in Rome. See the Fontanna della Barcaccia (Fountain of the Old Boat) in the middle of the piazza and enjoy the view from the famous Spanish Steps. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

DAY 9 Monday, June 9: Papal Basilicas of Rome | Institute of **Ursuline Sisters**

Breakfast at our hotel. The main distinction of the Papal Basilicas is that they each have a special "holy door" that is opened only during Jubilee years. Begin our day with a visit to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, one of the four major basilicas built by Pope Sixtus III (432-440 A.D.). View the impressive interior with its remarkable mosaics depicting scenes from the Old Testament. View relics of Jesus' manger from Bethlehem and the high altar, which contains the remains of St. Matthew the Evangelist. View the icon Salus Populi Romani, Protectress of the Roman People, believed to be painted by St. Luke. The mosaics above the entablature are among the most ancient Christian mosaics in Rome. Continue to the Cathedral of St. John Lateran, the first Christian church to be consecrated. It was founded by Emperor Constantine in the 4th century and home to popes for many years prior to the present Vatican residence. After our visit, we'll continue to the Basilica of St. Paul Outside-the-Walls, built by Constantine in the 4th century on the site of St. Paul's tomb. Surrounding the nave are medallions of each pope, from St. Peter to Pope Francis. Independent lunch.*

This afternoon we'll be transferred to the Ursuline Sisters of the Roman Union of the Order of St. Ursula.

*Possible meeting or reception lunch with the Ursuline Sisters. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome.

DAY 10 <u>Tuesday, June 10: Return to the USA</u>

After breakfast, we'll be transferred to Leonardo da Vinci-Fiumicino Airport for our return flight to the USA.

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. **Peter's Way Tours (PWT)** reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, PWT reserves the right to cancel your reservation. A \$50.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank returns a personal check, a \$50.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check, or debit/credit card. PWT collects funds on travelers' behalf and remits those funds to suppliers. PWT has no liability for suppliers' acts or omissions. CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: All tour deposits are non-refundable upon receipt. If you cancel from 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, all payments are non-refundable, including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments, or other costs. Travel insurance is mandated as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons (illness or injury). Travel insurance payments are non-refundable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be changed on roster or airline tickets. All refund requests are subject to cancellation terms set forth above. Costs for tour services that are not utilized are non-refundable. Travel insurance is included in your package price in order to protect your tour package investment. Please read all details very carefully under TRAVEL INSURANCE.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current international travel requirements. Beginning in 2025, visitors to the European Union may require additional travel documents to enter the EU. After enrolling you will be sent information to apply online for ETIAS prior to travel (if required). Each traveler is solely responsible for ensuring that all required travel documents are complete and current. PWT will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents (ie., passport, proof of vaccine, any required test results).

AIR TRANSPORTATION: This travel package includes round-trip estimated economy class airfare from Cincinnati or New York. Rates will be confirmed 11 months prior to departure. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing. All flights are booked under one itinerary. If a traveler does not travel on any one of the flights in the proper sequence, the rest of the reservation will be automatically canceled by the airline. Rebooking the canceled flight would be subject to a change fee and possible fare difference. If you purchase independent flights, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost(s) if you cancel participation for any reason. It is important that you do not purchase airline tickets until the group has been confirmed for travel by PWT.

AIRLINE SEATING: A group booking will be confirmed 11 months prior to departure. Under group contracts, seat selection is not permitted. Requests for seat preferences (window or aisle) may be made when you check in for the flight. There is no guarantee that requests will be honored. PWT cannot submit special seat requests on behalf of any passenger. Group reservations may not be accessed online for advance checkin/boarding passes/seat assignments. If seat selection is a condition that affects your decision to travel, it is suggested that you purchase the land only package in order to book your airline arrangements according to your specific needs.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: The estimated Land Only package price is \$4,345.00 per person sharing a twin room (\$200 cash discount will be applied if all payments are made by check). The Land Only package does not include group airfare. It is the traveler's responsibility to book airline tickets independently. Any tour participant may change their status to "Land Only" by notifying PWT in writing, up to 100 days prior to departure. Passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package, or deviating from the group itinerary, are responsible for their own transfers to/from the hotel/airport. However, if your flights coordinate with the groups' arrangements, you are welcome to utilize the group transfer(s). If you purchase your own airline transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel for any reason, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Overseas round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package for the group tour dates. It is the passenger's responsibility to make sure their luggage travels with them the entirety of the trip.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Married couples may request a double bed which is subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of \$895 will apply. We cannot guarantee roommate requests but will make every effort to pair you with another traveler, if double occupancy is requested. MEALS: Breakfast daily plus seven (7) dinners. including a festive meal at Cantine Santa Benedetta.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. Although voluntary, for good work we recommend €4 Euro per person per day for

your tour manager; $\in 2$ Euro per person per day for your bus driver; and $\in 1.50$ Euro per tour for local guides. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the package price. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave $\in 1$ Euro per person for the wait staff after each meal and $\in 1$ Euro per person per day for housekeeping.
